Be it enacted by the Senate and Assembly of the State of New York, in session assembled, That the laws relating to the incorporation of corporations...

Section 1. That the corporation is to be called the State Insurance Company

SENDS GREETING.

WHEREAS, In and by an act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, entitled "An Act to provide for the incorporation and regulation of certain corporations," approved the twenty-ninth day of April, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, ^{and the 1st March 1875} the Governor of this Commonwealth is authorized and required to issue LETTERS PATENT to all corporations formed under the provisions of said act embraced within the second class named therein.

AND WHEREAS, The stipulations, conditions and things directed to be performed in said recited act of the General Assembly, ^{and the 1st March 1875} have been fully complied with by *The West Hill Land Company* formed under the provisions of said recited act. The business of said corporation is to be transacted in *Jefferson* county, of *Delaware* State of Pennsylvania.

NOW KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the power and authority to me given by law, I, *John Hart* Governor of the said Commonwealth, DO, BY THESE PRESENTS, which I have caused to be made PATENT and sealed with the Great Seal of the State, create and erect the subscribers to the stock of the said corporation, for the number of shares by them subscribed, to wit:

Amounting in the whole to eight hundred shares

And also those who may thereafter become subscribers or holders of the stock of said corporation, into one body politic and corporate, in deed and in law, by the name, style and title of *The West Hill Land Company* and by the said name, the said subscribers shall have ^{succession for the term of twenty years} and all the privileges and franchises incident to a corporation. And the said subscribers, and those who shall afterwards subscribe to the stock of the said corporation, their successors and assigns, are generally to be treated with all the rights, powers and privileges, with full force and effect, and subject to all the duties, regulations and restrictions specified and enjoined in and by the said act of the General Assembly and all other laws of this Commonwealth.
