SECTION 2. That the county commissioners of Luzerne county, for the purpose of paying for the erection of the Luzerne county prison, may borrow money to an amount not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars, and execute bonds or certificates of indebtedness therefor, in the name of the county, pledging the faith and taxes of the county for the payment thereof at any time, not exceeding five years, and at a rate of interest not exceeding seven per cent. per annum, free from taxes of every kind; and the said commissioners are hereby empowered to do all and every act necessary to carry the provisions of this act into effect.

## A Supplement

To an act incorporating the Williamsport Water Company.

WHEREAS, By an act of assembly approved March twelfth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, the Williamsport Water Company were authorized to borrow any sum or sums of money not exceeding sixty thousand dollars, and as security for said loans the president and secretary of said company were authorized to execute judgment notes in the name of said company:

Preamble.

*And whereas,* The said company have found it inconvenient and expensive to secure the loan aforesaid by such judgment notes; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the president and secretary of the Williamsport Water Company are hereby authorized to execute, in the name and under the corporate seal of said company, bonds and mortgages, of like effect with said judgment notes, for all money borrowed by said company under the act of assembly aforesaid.

President and secretary authorized to execute bonds and mortgages.

SECTION 2. That all bonds and mortgages heretofore issued by the said company for money borrowed under the act of assembly aforesaid, are hereby legalized and declared to be

binding upon said company, with like effect as if the authority hereby granted were contained in the act of assembly aforesaid.

## An Act

To extend the provisions of an act relating to costs in Luzerne county, approved the second day of April, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, to the county of Schuylkill, with a proviso.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the several provisions of the act, entitled "An Act relating to costs in Luzerne county," approved the second day of April, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, be and the same are hereby extended to the county of Schuylkill: *Provided,* That the same shall apply only to the fees of sheriff, clerk of the court and district attorney, and only to cases where the costs cannot be collected from the person or persons liable to pay the same; and that the same shall apply to the costs of said officers in prosecutions in which a *nolle prosequi* has been entered by leave of court since September the first, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight.
