CHAP. XLVIII.

AN ACT to amend an act, to incorporate the Water Company of Franklin.

Sec. 1. *BE it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee,* That from and after the passage of this act, each and every person or persons owning a post or pipe in said town for the conveyance of water, be, and they are hereby appointed, in addition to those heretofore appointed, and be a part of the body corporate and politic, with equal powers, and subject to the same rules, regulations and restrictions, of those heretofore appointed for the Franklin Water Company.

Sec. 2. *Be it enacted,* That no person shall continue to be one of the body corporate or politic as aforesaid, any longer than he does hold the right, title or interest in and to a post or pipe for the conveyance of water in the town of Franklin aforesaid.

CHAP. XLIX.

AN ACT for the relief of Sheriffs.

Sec. 1. *BE it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee,* That the different sheriffs throughout this state, shall be allowed the term of two years two years allowed.
