No. 116.—AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE BURLING-TON AQUEDUCT COMPANY TO INCREASE ITS CAPITAL STOCK.

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

- SEC. 1. The Burlington Aqueduct Company is hereby authorized to increase its capital stock to an amount sufficient to enable it to carry out the purposes for which it was incorporated.
- The directors of said company may at any legal meeting thereof determine the number of shares by which said capital stock shall be increased, and prescribe the times and method of subscription to such additional capital stock, and the times and method by which assessments on such additional capital stock shall be paid in, and scrip issue therefor.
 - SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from its passage. Approved, November 21, 1864.
